Consilience opens new tasting room

Consilience has just opened a new tasting room and shop front for it's wins in downtown Los Olivos.

Created by Los Olivos-based Shannon Scott Design, the tasting plus retail and office space occupies 900 square feet that was formerly Oarlic's Antiques on Grand Avenue.

"The interior reflects the rustic elegance of the valley while capturing the unique identity of this innovative wine label," says

Shannon Scott, who chose slate, wood, glass and other natural materials to finish the project.

The tasting room also features original artwork, commissioned from local artist Erin Humfrey, to flank either side of the bar.

Consilience has its wines made at the Fess Parker Winery facilities on Foxen Canyon Road, just outside Los Olivos, and in Santa Maria.
